Registration Information

All registration materials are included in this packet, along with a checklist for your convenience. An optional orientation for **families who do not currently attend Casas Christian School** will be held to answer any other questions you might have (the time and date will be sent with your child's final schedule). We want all to feel comfortable and ready for a great experience here at Casas.

Completed registration and enrollment forms, as well as registration, course, and lunch fees, must be submitted in advance of the student's participation in classes. Class registration priority is given to those students who have submitted all their paperwork and paid all their registration and course fees in full. Supply fees will be billed when final schedules are mailed; these fees must be paid prior to the start of the applicable session.

Extended Care costs will be billed separately at the end of each session. Non-CCS families are required to leave a credit card number on file if they utilize the extended care program.

How to Register

1. Use the course schedule and descriptions in the FLIGHT packet to select classes.
2. Fill out the registration materials, and pay all fees prior to May 16 (Session I) and June 19 (Session II).
3. Mail or drop off registration materials, plus check or money order, for selected classes or option plan, lunch fees, and registration fee of \$40 to:

Registration Deadline for Summer Session I: June 5

Registration Deadline for Summer Session II: June 26

Late fee charge after May 16 (Session I) and June 19 (Session II) of \$25.

Payment

We accept payment by check, cash, or credit card (proper form to be completed by school office personnel for this type of payment).

Refund Policy

We offer full refunds for any cancelled classes or classes closed due to maximum enrollment. A 75% tuition refund will be given if a class is dropped prior to June 1st for Session I, and prior to June 29th for Session II. A 50% tuition refund will be given the week prior to each class. No refunds will be issued after classes start.

Student Final Schedule

Final schedules for each student will be mailed prior to the start of each session. Included with this schedule will be room number assignments and a bill for supply fees. Supply fees must be paid prior to the beginning of each session.

Age-Appropriate Groupings

Students will be grouped by grade level or “grade level range” (i.e., K-2 or 3-5) depending on the content and purpose of the course. Every effort will be made to place students in one of their choices. The Summer School Director or Assistant Director will notify you of any cancellations or alternate placements.

Discipline Policy

Please read and discuss the enclosed playground rules and discipline policy with your child. Please sign and return with your registration materials. No refunds will be made to students who are asked to leave the program because of misbehavior.

Safety

All students must be signed into the program each day. Parents will sign out their children directly from the teacher after the child’s last class, or from the Extended Care program depending upon the time of departure. Only those individuals listed on your child’s “blue card” will be allowed to sign out your child. A Driver’s License may be required for identification purposes. We appreciate your understanding and support in this matter.

Tuition and Fees

Registration Fee: A t-shirt is included in the non-refundable \$40 registration fee.

Session Fees:	1 Class per day	=	\$110
	2 Classes per day	=	\$200
	3 Classes per day	=	\$290
	4 Classes per day	=	\$340
	4 Classes + Extended Care	=	\$470

Please make the appropriate selections on the enclosed Registration Form.

Supply Fees: Individual class supply fees are noted in course description packet. These will be billed when the class assignments are finalized. These fees are used to purchase materials for the class activities.

Lunch/Snack: A lunch menu and prices are included in this packet. Participation in the lunch program is optional; students are welcome to bring their lunch if they choose. All lunch fees must be paid prior to the start of each session. Children should pack a snack for the morning snack time.

Extended Care

We provide safe, supervised care for summer students arriving before 8:15 a.m. or staying after 2:30 p.m. The fee is \$3.25 per hour, calculated to the nearest 15 minute increment, and billed at the end of each session. Extended Care is available from 6:30 - 8:15 a.m. and 2:30 - 6:00 p.m.

If a student is picked up after 6:00 p.m., there is a late charge of \$5.00 for the first 15 minutes, and \$10.00 for each additional 15 minute increment, or portion thereof. No refunds are given for Extended Care services as they are charged on an actual use basis.
