## **Class Fees**

Class fees are as indicated on the Registration form. Supply fees are additional and vary by class; please see the *Class Descriptions* or *Class Schedules* for pricing.

## **Refund Policy**

We offer full refunds for any cancelled classes or classes closed due to maximum enrollment. No refunds will be issued after classes begin.

## **Discipline Policy**

No refunds will be made to students who are asked to leave the program because of misbehavior.

## **Safety**

All students must be signed into the program each day. Parents will sign out their children directly from the teacher after the child's last class, or from the Extended Care program depending upon the time of departure. Only those individuals listed on your child's Emergency Information Form will be allowed to sign out your child. A driver's license may be required for identification purposes. We appreciate your understanding and support in this matter.

## **Snack/Lunch**

Children should pack a snack for the morning snack time. Also, make sure to send your child with a sack lunch if they are staying through the lunch period. Hot lunches are available on Wednesdays, Thursdays and Fridays; these need to be pre-ordered (please see enclosed flyer for further details).

## **Extended Care**

We provide safe, supervised care for students arriving before 8:00 a.m. or staying after 2:15 p.m. The fee is \$3.90 per hour, billed in 15 minute increments. Extended Care is available from 7:00-8:00 a.m. and 2:15-6:00 p.m.

If a student is picked up after 6:00 p.m., there is a late charge of \$5.00 for the first 15 minutes, and \$10.00 for each additional 15 minute increment or portion thereof. No refunds are given for Extended Care services as they are charged on an actual-use basis.

Extended Care costs will be billed separately at the end of each session.

## Class Descriptions for Grades 1-5

*(See Class Schedule for sessions & times offered.)*

**American Girl Club** (*Gr 1-3*) Travel through history with the American Girls. We'll learn, cook, and craft based upon the historical time and place from which the dolls originated. American Girl Dolls not required. (*Supply Fee- \$5*)

**Animals in Art** (*Gr 3-5*) Using animals as inspiration, the students will create artwork focusing on both realistic and fantasy animals. Students will explore animals in art using line, shape, and color. (*Supply Fee- \$9*)

**Archery** (*Gr 3-5*) Bullseye!! Learn how to safely use a bow and arrow and become a real archer! We will be shooting at a variety of targets and participating in fun tournaments with prizes. (*Supply Fee- \$6*)

**Babysitting 101** (*Gr 3-5*) Do you love babies and little kids? Are you responsible and caring? If you answered yes to either question this class is the one for you! Discover how to entertain children of all ages in a babysitter preparation class. We'll learn games, songs, snacks, and projects that children of all ages will love. Each student will create a Babysitter Survival Kit and have a chance to practice their new skills with super cute babies and kids! (*Supply Fee- \$4*)

**Baking Buddies** (*Gr 1-3*) Do you enjoy working in the kitchen? Get together with friends and have fun creating yummy dishes that will impress your parents! (*Supply Fee- \$11*)

**Basketball Skills & Drills** (*Gr 3-5*) Hype up your basketball game by participating in various drills to improve your skills in ball handling, lay-ups, and shooting the two-pointers! Show off your newly adopted skills in 3:3 and 5:5 scrimmages. (*Supply Fee- none*)

**Building Bridges** (*Gr 3-5*) "London Bridge is falling down, falling down..." Even though you can't save the London Bridge, perhaps you can save others. Bridges are a large part of our world. They connect states, towns, streets and lives. As a group of architects, you will design and build four bridges. (*Supply Fee- \$12*)

**CCS Chopped** (*Gr 3-5*) Work with a team to prepare dishes from secret ingredients revealed at the last minute. Then compete with other classmates in challenges. Try not to get "Chopped!" (*Supply Fee- \$17*)

**CCS Olympics** (*Gr 3-5*) The gold is within your reach! We will be choosing countries, making flags, and playing a variety of individual and team activities. There will be medals and prizes for sportsmanship and teamwork. (*Supply Fee- none*)

**CCS (Jr) Olympics** (*Gr 1-3*) The gold is within your reach! We will be choosing countries, making flags, and playing a variety of individual and team activities. There will be medals and prizes for sportsmanship and teamwork. (*Supply Fee- none*)

**Chocolate Factory** (*Gr 1-3, 3-5*) Willy Wonka has nothing on us! If you love chocolate (Who doesn't?), join us as we experience making, baking, painting, and exploring all that is related to the culinary wonder. In addition to designing our own candy bars, we will make lots of tasty treats and enjoy chocolate-related activities. (*Supply Fee- \$14*)

**Craft Craze** (*Gr 3-5*) If glitter, feathers, glue, painting, and coloring spell fun for you, then you are a perfect fit for this class! Join us while we explore the fun world of crafting, where our endless creativity will take charge! (*Supply Fee- \$12*)

**Crazy Chemistry** (Gr 1-3, 3-5) Can you blow up a balloon without using your mouth? Yes, you can. Can you produce heat without a fire or electricity? You can do that too. You can even make rock candy without any rocks. If you want to learn crazy chemistry secrets, this class is for you. (Supply Fee- \$12)

**Creation Station** (Gr 1-3) Are the wheels in your brain constantly turning? Are you always thinking of things you'd like to make or build? Creation Station gives you an opportunity to construct, create, and craft interesting objects. We'll use craft sticks to build bird feeders, jewelry boxes, slingshots and other neat projects! Let's use our creativity to build, build, build! (Supply Fee- \$12)

**Dance/Cheer** (Gr 1-5) Learn basic cheer motions, jumps, a sideline dance, jazz dance techniques, and a performance piece. We'll perform at the end of the session for parents to celebrate your progress! (Supply Fee- \$8)

**Duct Tape Art** (Gr 1-3) Did you know you could make your own wallet out of duct tape? In addition to wallets, we will make rose pens, pencil bags, and other fun crafts – all created with colorful duct tape! This class will be a blast for both boys and girls. (Supply Fee- \$11)

**Dynamic Earth** (Gr 3-5) Investigate what fossils, rocks and minerals can reveal about our Planet Earth. Explore the fossil record, the different rock forms, and the fascinating gemstones within. Create your own fossil print, sand and polish a piece of amber millions of years old, and crack open a geode. (Supply Fee- \$5)

**Edible Experiments** (Gr 1-3, 3-5) Experience hands-on fun with interesting experiments, and then eat the finished product! This will be one interesting and tasty class! (Supply Fee- \$11)

**Game On!** (Gr 1-3) We are going to stay busy all week playing games! Learn how to play a variety of board and card games. Challenge friends in checkers, chess, dominoes, cup-stacking, and more! Even explore the world of Legos! You may even learn some classic games such as marbles, jacks, and pick-up-sticks. (Supply Fee- none)

**Gardening Group** (Gr 1-3) Are you interested in learning all about planting? We will prepare indoor and outdoor gardens, tend to the plants, water and observe. We will also make fun garden art and bird feeders! (Supply Fee- \$11)

**I Heart Art** (Gr 1-3) Do you like expressing yourself with art? Do you enjoy drawing, painting, and working with clay? Then this class is for you! Use your imagination as you get creative and have fun creating art. You will experiment with clay, paint, paper and paper maché. Please bring a smock to the first class. (Supply Fee- \$5)

**Indoor Games** (Gr 1-5) On your mark, get set, go!! Join us as we play a variety of strategic and active indoor games making this class fast-paced and SUPER fun! (Supply Fee- none)

**Kids' Cuisine** (Gr 1-3) What can we "cook up" this summer? We will be trying new recipes as we practice kitchen safety. At the end of the course, you'll have a collection of recipes and enough "know how" to be a big help in the kitchen. (Supply Fee- \$12)

**LegoMania** (Gr 1-3) Use your creativity to build vehicles, structures, and cities. Come have fun, learn to share, build cool structures, and let your creativity shine! (Supply Fee- \$10)

**Let It Fly!** (Gr 3-5) Participants will build and fly simple projects. No special skills are required for this workshop. Some activities will have a planned design and others will be experimental. (Supply Fee- \$10)

**Literacy Lounge** (Gr 1-3) Participate in author and genre studies where you'll enjoy read alouds and projects. Practice comprehension strategies through book talks and crafts in the style of the authors and illustrators. (Supply Fee- \$4)

**Math Path** (*Gr 1-3*) Stay on track with math this summer! If you're looking to have some fun with math, join us for games that are easy to learn and fun to play! You will discover new problem-solving strategies and shortcuts, and personalize your favorite games to take home and enjoy with your friends and family. (*Supply Fee- none*)

**Mighty Math** (*Gr 1-3*) In this class we will read math-related stories and explore various mathematical concepts such as numeration, graphing, measurement, money and geometry. In addition, we will play math games like Uno, Trouble, Dominoes and Bingo. Come join us to have cool summer fun being a Mighty Mathematician! (*Supply Fee- none*)

**Minecraft** (*Gr 3-5*) Delve into the exciting 3D computer game of Minecraft that teaches creative thinking; a game where you dig (Mine) and build (craft) 3D blocks within varying terrains and habitats. Several levels of difficulty and the ability to challenge an opponent make this a game that appeals to all ages! (*Supply Fee- \$6*)

**Minute to Win It** (*Gr 1-3, 3-5*) Compete in this fast-paced fun game with the silliest competitions ever! Will you be the next Minute champion? (*Supply Fee- \$8*)

**Model Rocketry II** (*Gr 3-5*) This class takes Intro to Model Rocketry to higher level of instruction where participants will build a more challenging rocket (Please do not register for this class unless your child has had experience building several model rockets or other model kits). Since we will be working to complete and fly our project, regular attendance is essential. (*Supply Fee- \$18*)

**Move It!** (*Gr 1-3, 3-5*) Play games and engage in fun physical activities and sports that will strengthen and develop your body, while staying cool indoors. Let's get moving! (*Supply Fee- none*)

**Non-Stop Art** (*Gr 1-3*) Great art awaits you! You will have the opportunity to paint an Aztec painting with thick paint, create black ink zentangle designs, and paint a beautiful landscape with watercolor. Non-Stop Art will be non-stop fun! (*Supply Fee- \$5*)

**Once Upon a Time** (*Gr 3-5*) In this creative writing workshop you will have an opportunity to explore and discuss the components of a good story and apply these elements to your own writing. Through daily reading activities and journaling in your writing notebook, you will brainstorm, develop, and nurture your own creative ideas to include in your stories. You will ultimately produce your own storybook to share with your classmates in our culminating short story festival, and keep it as a reminder of your literary success! (*Supply Fee- \$6*)

**PE Super Games** (*Gr 1-5*) Have fun playing a mix of indoor and outdoor games like *Medic*, *Eliminator*, and *Capture the Flag*. Some games you might already know and love; some will be new to you, but all of them will be SUPER! (*Supply Fee- none*)

**Play-Doh Creations** (*Gr 1-3*) Mold, shape, cut and design! You can use accessories and molds to create meals, make faces, decorate a party cake or create jungle friends! Roll, pat or press a body shape using Play-Doh and let the fun begin as you add eyes, ears, a nose and mouth. Or maybe it's all ears, or half animal, half human. Perhaps it's a googly-eyed alien! The possibilities are endless! (*Supply Fee- \$8*)

**Reading Connection** (*Gr 1-3*) Do you need a boost in reading? Increase your fluency and comprehension with phonics review through fun games and activities in a relaxed, enjoyable environment! (*Supply Fee- none*)

**Science Olympics** (*Gr 1-3*) Here's your chance to participate in a competitive challenges that demonstrate the fun side of science. Teams will use science skills and ideas to develop creative solutions to problems. How can you make a bridge out of a newspaper or make a straw tower strong enough to hold a tennis ball? Test your theories, compete with your friends, and go for the gold! (*Supply Fee- \$10*)

**Sparkle and Shine** (*Gr 1-3*) Bring your jewelry ideas to life! You get to be the designer as you learn techniques to create beaded necklaces, stamped metal bracelets, earrings, and much more. Just a little sparkle and a lot of shine will make any day! (*Supply Fee- \$14*)

**Sugar Rush** (*Gr 3-5*) Willy Wonka's world was made of candy, why can't yours? Come explore the other side of Gobstoppers, Nerds and gummy bears. Do you think it's possible to build a bridge using only Twizzlers, gum drops and bubble gum? How about a tower of chocolate drops, suckers, and cookies? Get ready to use your building skills and enjoy your yummy creations! (*Supply Fee- \$12*)

**Super Sleuths** (*Gr 3-5*) Learn how to be a junior detective! Understand what clues are and how reading clues can lead you to solve a mystery! (*Supply Fee- \$8*)

**Under the Sea** (*Gr 1-3*) Our oceans are full of beauty and wonder, a separate world waiting for us to explore. We will become ocean explorers this summer and learn about the mysteries of the oceans! We will research different ocean animals through books and videos, and create amazing ocean animal crafts. Through fun-filled ocean games, experiments, and arts and crafts we will become experts on our oceans! (*Supply Fee- \$6*)

**Wacky Waffles** (*Gr 3-5*) Plain waffles are so passé! This class will bring you to the new age of waffle ironing. Waffle omelets, waffle cinnamon rolls, waffle pizza...the list goes on and on! Come and discover what this simple kitchen appliance can do for you! (*Supply Fee- \$14*)

**What If?** (*Gr 1-3*) What would happen...if? This is a question that drives scientists of all ages! Perform hands-on experiments to answer new questions everyday. Fun, inquiry-based activities will create a desire to explore your natural world while developing your thinking and reasoning skills. (*Supply Fee- \$12*)

**Worship Team** (*Gr 1-5*) If you have a heart for worship, come be a part of the on-stage worship team! You'll learn the words and motions to several different worship songs and share them on-stage during Chapel time. (*Supply Fee- none*)

## Playground Rules

### Summer 2018

Playground Rules: These rules have been developed to help ensure the safety of the students at CCS. We are trying to instill self-discipline and responsibility in them by making them accountable for their actions. These rules may not include everything that could come up relative to student safety or conduct, so they should not be interpreted in that way. Playground staff and teachers will make the final decision regarding any questionable activities not mentioned in this document. These playground rules apply to ALL recess times and Extended Care hours.

1. Students need to use self-control while playing, and line up immediately when the whistle is blown by a teacher/supervisor.
2. Everyone is expected to show courtesy and respect to others and their property at all times. Students need to refer to others by the name they wish to be called and be honest and trustworthy.
3. Harassment of any type (bullying, threatening, name-calling, derogatory comments, unnecessary or offensive touching) will not be tolerated. Anyone who exhibits these behaviors should be reported to an adult and disciplined per school policy.
4. Any toy brought from home is the student's responsibility. If it creates a problem, the toy will be put away or held by the teacher until the end of the day. Any type of toy that would be dangerous in our playground area will be confiscated. Toys or items that are not appropriate for our playground include, but are not limited to: dolls of any kind, toys with "evil" powers, any type of play or real weapon, nail polish and make-up (K-5), all electronic devices, bats or hardballs.
5. Electronic Equipment: Cell phones must remain off and unseen both during the school day and after school. All electronic gaming and music devices are to be left at home so that they are not lost, damaged, or become an unnecessary distraction for other students. If a student needs to contact a parent he/she must get permission from an extended care staff person. Students may only use phones to contact parents at the end of the school day.
6. Any type of aggressive activity or game involving fighting, hitting, pushing, tackling, wrestling, kicking others, tripping, war-type games or play-fighting, throwing balls or objects at others will not be allowed (with the exception of play within a game). Students must use a foam ball when playing any form of ball tag or dodge ball. Ball tag is not permitted on the climbing equipment.
7. Games such as soccer, kickball, basketball, etc. are to be played according to the traditional rules of that particular game. Running through or disrupting games are not allowed. Games must not be played with unnecessary roughness or tackling. All students will treat one another fairly and appropriately and will accept the decisions of the supervisors.
8. Jumping off of or playing tag on the equipment is not permitted. Students should not play tag under the ramada. Students may not push or pull others while on equipment. Students may not stand on, run across, or jump off the tables.
9. Ga-Ga Ball Pit:
  - Players hit the ball with their hands only and may not carry or throw the ball - it must be hit with open hand or fist.
  - Any player who is touched by the ball either directly or by a rebound off the wall is "out", then must exit the pit.
  - Do not sit on or hop over the wall. Do not sit or lay down in the Ga-Ga Pit.

**10. Swings:**

- Running through or playing near moving swings is not permitted.
- Only one person is allowed on a swing at a time, and he or she must be properly seated.
- Jumping off swings and swinging side to side is not allowed.
- Do not twist the swing chains.
- Do not "save" swings for friends.
- No "cherry drops" or "underdogs" or hanging from swing chains.
- No one is allowed to climb up the swing set legs.

**11. Red Jungle Gym:**

- Do not hang upside down on the two highest horizontal bars.
- Do not sit for long periods of time on top of the ladder.
- Student's hands and feet are to be on the fireman's pole while sliding down.
- No standing or walking on top of bars.

**12. Wallcano:**

- Only 4 students may be on the top platform at one time.
- Students may not jump off the top or sides of the Wallcano.

**13. Wilderness Hideout:**

- No sitting on or jumping off of the top log tunnel.
- No sitting on or jumping off of the taller light green bars (nearest to the climbing wall).

**14.** No one is allowed outside the fenced area without permission. If a ball goes over a fence, one child may retrieve the ball with the teacher's permission and observation. Students may not climb or jump over fences.

**15.** Students are to acquire permission to leave the playground to use the bathroom. They will be sent in pairs of the same gender. Staff member will ensure students return in adequate time.

**16.** No glass containers are to be brought to school.

**17.** Animals may not be brought to the school playground.

**18.** Any student who is eating within the playground area must be seated (to avoid choking) at a picnic table and must properly dispose of any trash. All middle school students need to eat their lunches at a table, whether that is in the lunchroom, on the food court, or on the playground.

**19.** The ramada misters may be turned on by CCS personnel only.

**20.** Be cautious near the water fountain; check for bees, and do not leave the water fountain running. Water fights or digging near the water fountain are not permitted.

## CCS Summer School Program Discipline Agreement - 2018

Discipline expectations during the summer at CCS mirror our student expectations throughout the regular school year. The purposes of discipline at CCS are as follows:

1. To develop and encourage Christian character and behavior patterns.
2. To maintain an optimum learning environment.
3. To provide safety for all students.
4. To enforce CCS rules for the good of the whole student body.
5. To provide enforcement of both governmental and moral laws.

Unacceptable behavior during our summer program will be handled on two levels.

**Level 1:** These offenses would include normal classroom type problems which will be handled by the teacher or supervisor of the class. These would include problems such as excessive talking, disobeying directions, and any other action that would disturb the ability of the teacher to instruct or other students to learn and enjoy the class. Teachers will have the discretion to respond to these discipline cases in ways that match the child's maturity level, including time out, withdrawal of privileges, etc.

**Level 2:** These offenses would include more serious behavior problems and/or a continuation of Level 1 offenses after warnings and consequences. This could include attitude problems such as a lack of respect for authority, others, and/or property, fighting, profanity, talking back, verbally abusing others, bullying, and lack of self control that is harmful to the classroom environment and/or to other students. Level 2 offenses will be handled by the FLIGHT Director and/or CCS Principal. Parents will be contacted for Level 2 offenses and consequences will be determined as specified below.

### **Level 2 Consequences:**

- First offense: Student removed from the environment and a call made to parents.
- Second offense: Parent meeting with FLIGHT Director and/or CCS Principal; 1 day suspension from the program.
- Third offense: Parent meeting with FLIGHT Director and/or CCS Principal; the student must withdraw from the program.

**Zero Tolerance Policy:** Behaviors that will not be tolerated in our Summer Program are as follows: threatening or severely endangering another's safety, property damage, possession of illegal weapons or substances, leaving the school grounds without permission, bullying, repeated disobedience or defiance of school rules or authorities. These offenses will be handled by the FLIGHT Director and/or CCS Principal, and consequences will result in the immediate withdrawal from our summer program.
