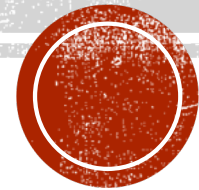

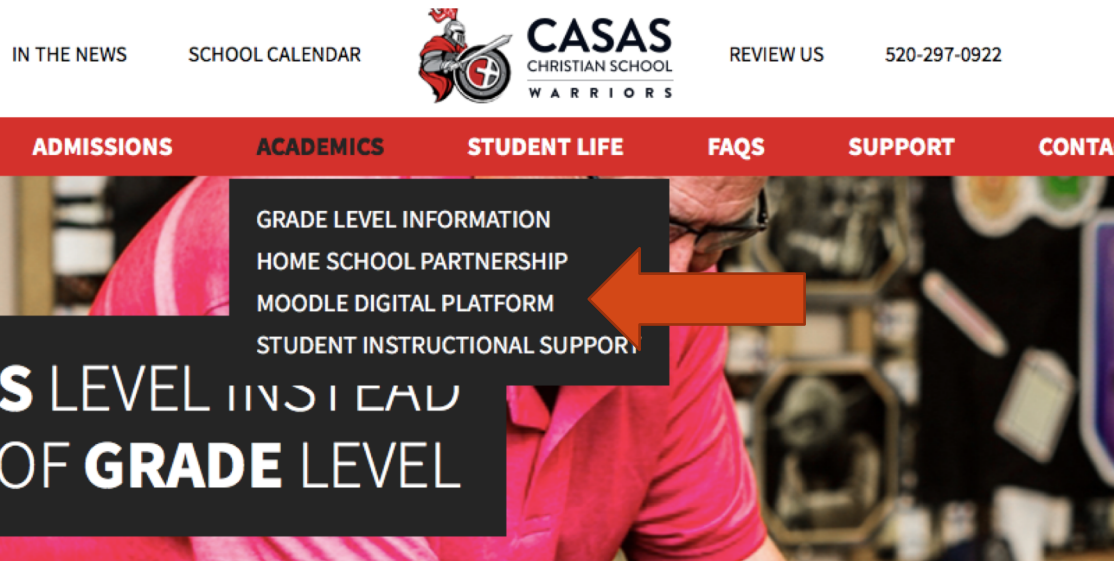
....you will learn how to:

- Access support for questions




SIGN IN TO MOODLE OPTION 1

1. Go to www.casaschristianschool.com
2. Click on the Academics tab
3. Choose Moodle Digital Platform
4. Enter your user name and password (sent to parent email address – unique login for each student)



SIGN IN TO MOODLE OPTION 2


1. Type the following in to a web browser:

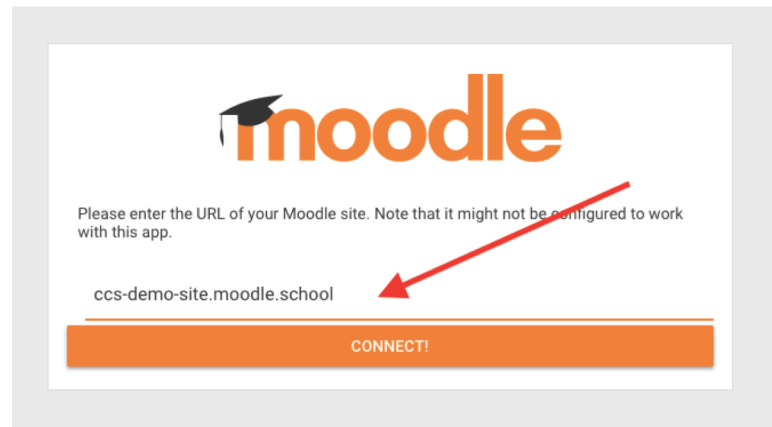
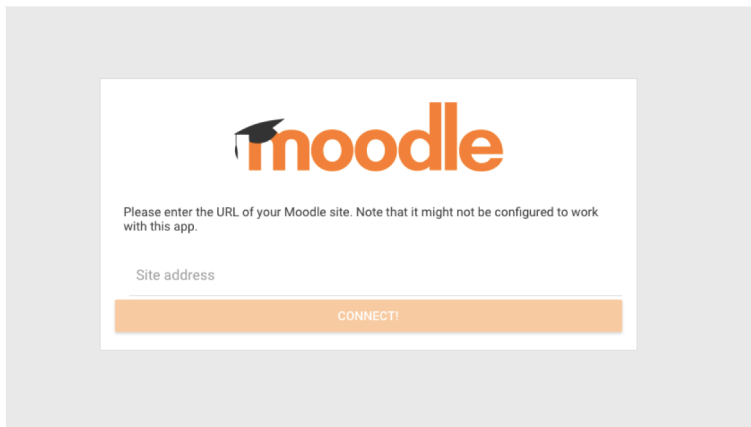

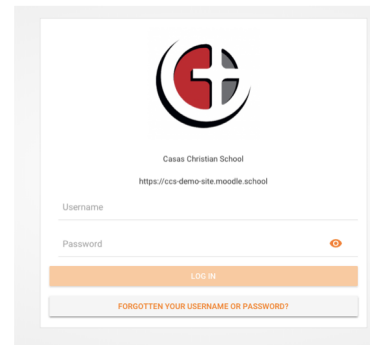
SIGN IN TO MOODLE

OPTION 3

1. Download the Moodle App from the Google Play store or App Store
2. Open the app
3. Enter our school site information (first time only): `ccs-demo-site.moodle.school`

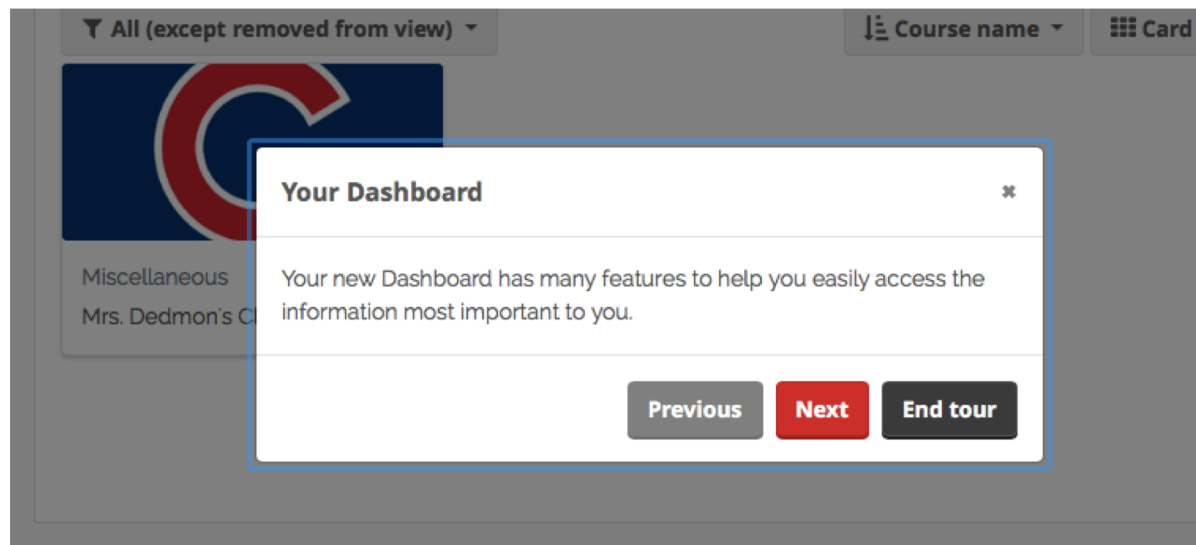


4. Log in with student user name and password



HOW TO ENTER A COURSE:

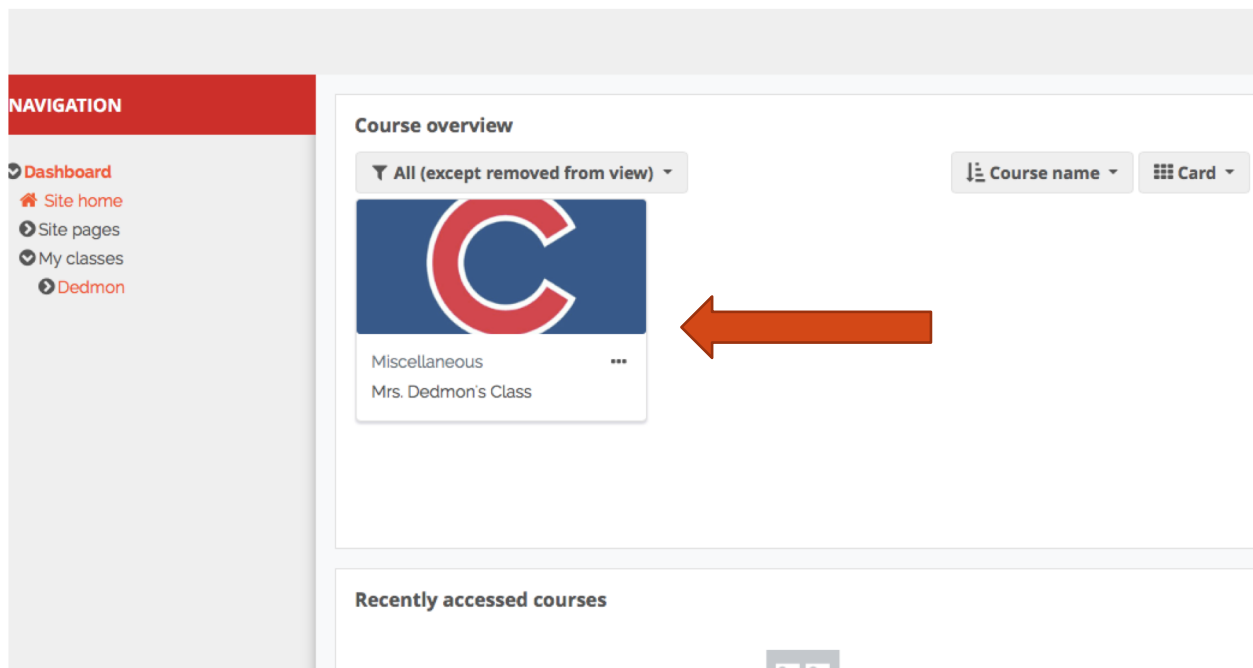
On a student's initial login, you will be prompted to take a brief tour. You may click through the tour or choose to end it at any time.



HOW TO ENTER A COURSE (CONT'D):

Your student will be enrolled in one or more courses (depending on grade level).

To enter a course, simply click on the picture.



TO ACCESS YOUR CONTENT:

You are ready to begin! Your teacher has designed a whole classroom in this virtual world!

Click on a link to open up a video, assignment, quiz, discussion forum and more!




TO ACCESS YOUR CONTENT (CONT'D):



TO SUBMIT AN ASSIGNMENT TO YOUR TEACHER:

You may need to complete an assignment at home and submit it for grading to your teacher. This will be done through a file upload. You may take a photo of the work, scan the work using a scanner, or use the Notes app (only on iPhones).

Submitting a photo of work from a phone is done easiest through the Moodle App (not website).

To submit your work:

Step 1: Take a picture or scan of your work on a device.

Step 2: Open the Moodle app on your phone or tablet device that you took the photo/scan on.

Step 3: Click on the course you want to enter.

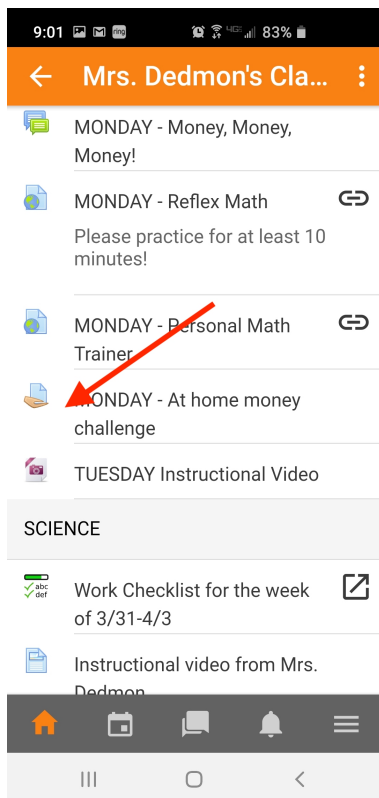

TO SUBMIT AN ASSIGNMENT TO YOUR TEACHER (CONT'D):

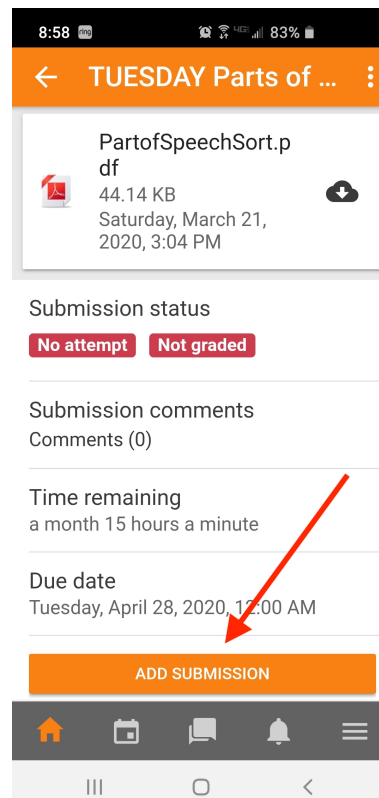
Step 4:

Click on the appropriate assignment



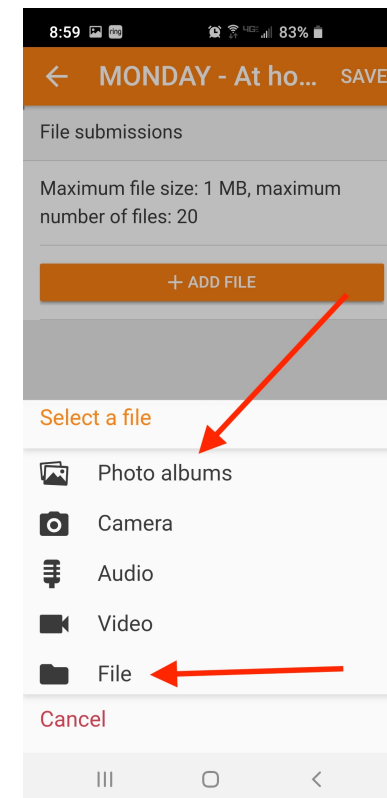
Step 5:

Step 6:

Choose photo album or file (depending on your device)

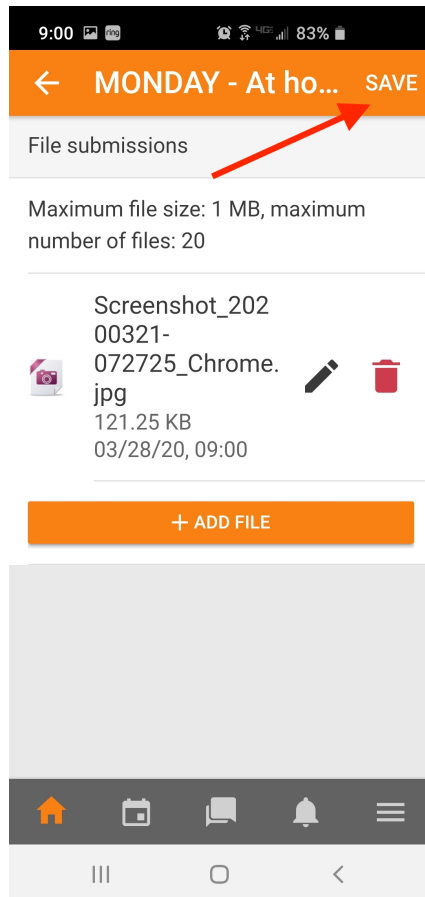


TO SUBMIT AN ASSIGNMENT TO YOUR TEACHER (CONT'D):

Step 7:

Once you have chosen the file or files you want to submit, click SAVE at the top right.

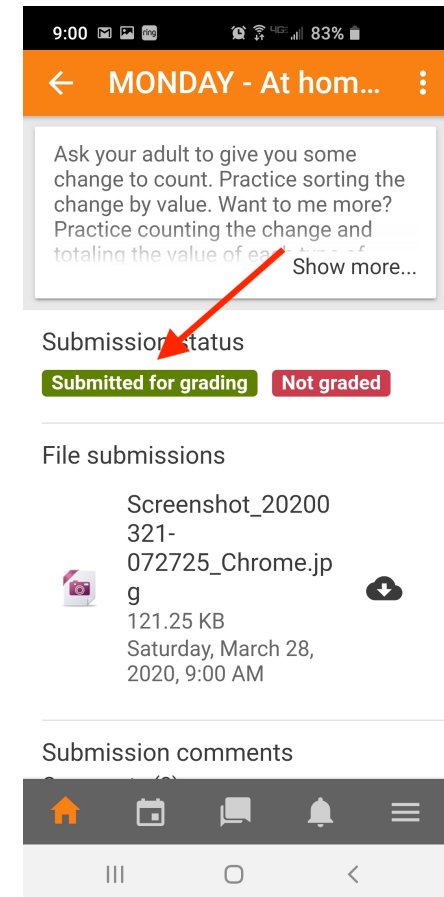
You can add more than one file!

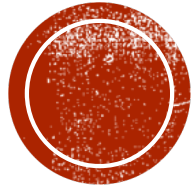
